RULE SUMMARY

These rules implement provisions enacted by the 2009 Legislative Assembly pertaining to the review of proposed schedule or table of premium rates filed for health benefit plans for small employers, individual health benefit plans and portability health benefit plans. The rules clarify the public process established by the Legislative Assembly for these filings and for individual and small employer group plans, specify the materials that must be submitted in a schedule or table of premium rate filing. For those filings, the rules also provide clarification of the factors the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services will consider in approving, disapproving or modifying the proposed rates and for approving an increase in administrative expenses that may be included in a rate.

The Agency requests public comment on whether other options should be considered for achieving the rule's substantive goals while reducing the negative economic impact of the rule on business.
