Oregon is a member of the Interstate Insurance Compact, which reviews certain insurance products before they can be sold. These products include life insurance, annuities, disability income and long-term care insurance. Compact policies must meet uniform standards, including strong consumer protections. Insurance companies can file products with the Compact representing multiple states or with individual states. By joining the Compact, Oregon seeks to streamline the approval process so that consumers have new insurance products more quickly available to them.

In all cases, whether an insurance product is approved for sale by the Compact or by the Oregon Insurance Division, consumers with questions or complaints may contact the division's consumer advocates at 888-877-4894.
