9 **Uniform Workers' Compensation Statistical Plan**

10 (1) The Unit Report Expanded (URE) Workers Compensation Statistical Plan, Edition of
11 July 1, 2001 filed by the National Council on Compensation Insurance and approved by the
12 Director to become effective January 1, 2002 is prescribed as the statistical plan for workers'
13 compensation insurance. In addition:

14 (a) The January 1, 2004 edition of Part 8, Pension Tables, of the NCCI URE Workers
15 Compensation Statistical Plan is prescribed as the pension tables effective in this state January 1,
16 2004.

17 (b) The January 1, 2006, edition of the Part 4, Paragraph 6, Gross Losses, and Paragraph
18 35, Deductible Reimbursement; and Part 5, Paragraph 2, Correction Reports, are prescribed as
19 the statistical plan for the Oregon Employer Paid Medical Program Limits effective January 1,
20 2006.

21 (c) The January 1, 2005, edition of Part 4, Paragraph 1, Reporting Losses, Paragraph 16,
22 Fraud Amount, Paragraph 20, Loss Condition, and Paragraph 30, Fraudulent Claim; Part 5,
23 Paragraph 2, Correction Reports; and Part 7, Paragraph 17, Fraudulent Claim are prescribed as
24 the statistical plan for Fraudulent Claims effective July 7, 2008.

25 (d) The January 1, 2005, edition of Part 1, Paragraph 16, Date of Valuation and Filing;
26 Part 4, Paragraph 11, Reporting of Assessments and Special Funds, Paragraph 15, Subrogation
27 Amount; and Part 5, Paragraph 1, Subsequent Reports, and Paragraph 2, Correction Reports are
28 prescribed as the statistical plan for the Addition of 6th-10th Report Levels effective July 7, 2008.

29 (e) The January 1, 2006, edition of the Part 4, Paragraph 6, Gross Losses, and Paragraph
30 35, Deductible Reimbursement; and Part 5, Paragraph 2, Correction Reports, are prescribed as
31 the statistical plan for the Oregon Employer Paid Medical Program Limits effective January 1,
32 2009.

33 **(f) The January 1, 2002, edition of Part 3 – Exposure Information, Paragraph 14,**
34 **Statistical Codes – Premium Amount Not Subject to Experience Modification; and Part 7 –**
35 **Coding Specifications, Paragraph 9, Statistical Codes – Premium Amount Not Subject to**
36 **Experience Modification effective September 1, 2008.**

37 (2) The State Accident Insurance Fund Corporation and each insurer transacting workers'
38 compensation insurance in this state shall report statistics for such business to the workers'
39 compensation rating organization of which it is a member according to the statistical plan
40 prescribed by section (1) of this rule.

41 (3) The amendments in section (1) of this rule, which were filed in ID 7-2003 with the
42 Secretary of State on December 3, 2003 to become effective on January 1, 2004, are re-adopted
43 with the operative date of January 1, 2004.
